ATDC NATIONAL RALLY 2021: CLASSES

- **CLUB AWARDS** (only awarded to a Club member in a Club eligible car)
Pride of Ownership Awards for 1st, 2nd or 3rd place, in Class 1 to 6
 - **CLASS 1** 10 hp CHROME RAD - Austin 10/4 models with flat exposed radiator cores. 1932-34, plus vans to 1936.
 - **CLASS 2** 10 hp COWLED RAD - Austin 10/4 models, with cowled radiators. 1934-36 – Lichfield, Sherborne, Ripley, Gordon Pixie and 10hp Sports models from 1933; Colwyn, Open Road and Clifton models up to 1937.
 - **CLASS 3** 10hp CAMBRIDGE - Austin 10hp 1936-39. Cambridge, Conway, Cambridge van.
 - **CLASS 4** 12-20hp CHROME RAD - All larger models with flat exposed radiator cores. Saloons 1931-1934, open cars up to 1935 and vans.
 - **CLASS 5** 12-28hp COWLED RAD - All larger models, with cowled radiators, 1934-39. Includes; Lt 12/6 Sports models from 1933 and the “New Ascot / Goodwood” style cars & vans from 1936.
 - **CLASS 6** PREVIOUS WINNERS– All class winners from Classes 1- 5, from the last 5 years.
 - **CLASS 7** OTHER AUSTINS AND CARS OF INTEREST
The Jim Richardson Award, to any ATDC Member entered in the Rally,
Includes all Austin models 1905-1948 not covered by the Class 1-5 above i.e. – Edwardian, Vintage, Sevens, Big Sevens, Eights and 10-16hp “Alligator Bonnet” models from 1939 to 1948. Also to be included, is any make of car or light commercial, in the ‘Historic Vehicles’ category for tax.
 - **CLASS 8** As in Class 7 above, but for non Club members
A First Prize and Position Rosettes, will be awarded to Guest Rally entrants.
- NOTE** [Class 7 and 8 will be judged independently, NOT under Pride of Ownership rules]

- **Regional Shield** – Awarded to the most popular car by public ballot.
- **Fred Pace Memorial Trophy** – Best 10/4 Two Seat & Dickey / Clifton in Classes 1 or 2
(Cars transported to the event on trailers are not eligible for this Trophy.)
- **Kit Le Marquand Trophy** - Best Club Eligible 6 cylinder car 16hp and above in Class 5.
- **Gary Ward Memorial Trophy** – Awarded to the winning driver & navigator in the Scatter Run treasure hunt in a Club-eligible Austin (10-28hp 1931-39)
- **Long Distance Awards** – Farthest distance driven in a Club-eligible Austin in order to reach the event. Two prizes – GB and Overseas. (Cars transported on trailers not eligible for these awards).
- **Worst Breakdown Award** – Most catastrophic breakdown sustained by a Club-eligible Austin on the way to or during the event. Cars recovered on trailer are eligible!
- **Everyday Shield** – Car in regular use throughout year. (Cars transported to this event on trailers, not eligible).
- **Light Twelve Shield** Best Lt12/4 or 12/6 in classes 4 or 5.

MAJOR AWARDS (only awarded to a Club member in a Club- eligible car)

- **The Longbridge Shield** – For a specified area of the car, “As it left Longbridge”
(members will be advised via the magazine which area will be inspected).
- **Driving Test [Men]** – Best gentleman’s score in driving tests in a Club- eligible car
- **Driving Test [Ladies]** – Best lady’s score in the driving tests in a Club- eligible car
- **The 10/4 Challenge Cup** – Best combined Pride of Ownership and Driving Test scores, 10hp
- **The 12-28 Challenge Cup** – Best combined Pride of Ownership and Driving Test scores, 12-28hp

NB Judging and Prize Awards – Chief Judge’s decisions are final.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMATION

Please read all the conditions of entry on this page before signing your declaration on page 2:

VEHICLE CONDITION

All vehicles entered for the National Rally must be in a roadworthy condition and registered with the tax office (not SORN). All vehicles must be insured. Drivers must also be covered by insurance to drive the vehicle.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS - ATDC NATIONAL RALLY 2021

These form part of the conditions of entry. ATDC is a drivers' club and we rely on the knowledge and experience of members to ensure safe and enjoyable events. However, familiarity can lead to momentary lapses of care or departures from good practice and as organisers of a motoring event we are not allowed to assume common sense will always prevail.

DRIVING & VEHICLE SAFETY

To ensure safe enjoyment of your event please follow these guidelines:-

YOU MUST

- Obey the instructions of the rally marshals including during the Driving Tests
- Check that your vehicle has no fuel leaks
- Obey posted speed limits on site
- If moving your vehicle after dark do so with extreme caution

YOU MUST NOT

- Refuel your vehicle within the Royal Agricultural University grounds
- Drink and drive above the legal limit
- Allow anyone without a licence or insurance drive your vehicle

YOU SHOULD

- Make use of any designated vehicle movement routes
- Minimize car movements on the rally field
- Avoid reversing on the rally field
- Keep your car speed down to a walking pace on the rally field
- Pedestrians - please keep clear of moving cars and allow space for drivers to manoeuvre their vehicles

PETS

Pets are allowed in the grounds of the Royal Agricultural University but not in any of the buildings including bedrooms except service dogs. There is zero tolerance to dogs being kept in cars at any time of year, regardless of windows being left open or regular checks".

FOOD, DRINK ETC.

Entrants can bring their own picnic food. There is a Coffee Shop and the Servery which will be open as follows:

Coffee Shop: open from 8.00am – 5.00pm on Friday 6th August. The Servery sells sandwiches, teas and coffee and will be open all day on both Saturday 7th August and Sunday 8th August.

The University are unable to supply any outdoor seating, so please bring your own along with tables if you have them.
