Supplementary Regulations

The Riley Register, on behalf of the Inter-Register Club, will organise a Navigational Scatter Rally starting at The Herb Farm, Sonning Common, South Oxon, RG4 9NJ (GR 712797) and finishing at Sulhamstead Village Hall RG7 4DD (GR635682 @SH 84). The event will be a round of the 2024 Inter-Register Club Championship, but is open to entrants in any type/age of car. The meeting is governed by the General Regulations of the RAC Motor Sports Association, the supplementary regulations and any written instructions that are issued by the club. MSA Permit: 200334.

The event is open to pre-1963 cars entered by fully elected members of clubs comprising the Inter-Register Club, the VSCC and other invited clubs. Entrants are also welcome in any Classic/Modern cars. All Entrants should ensure that their insurance will cover them for this type of event.

The maximum entry will be 30, with priority to Vintage cars if over-subscribed. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event should less than 12 entries be received. Entries open on publication of these Regulations and close on November 11th.

Entries must be on the official entry form and include the appropriate payment.

Program of the Meeting:

4pm Scrutineering and Signing On at The Herb Farm.

4.45pm ..Drivers Briefing

5pm Route Cards issued, with the finish approximately 5hrs later, in Sulhamstead.

Tea/coffee will be available at the Start and a hot meal at the Finish. A licensed bar will be open.

Entrants will require OS Landranger map 175- any recent edition should suffice. A roamer, pencils, rubber, ruler, highlighters, magnetic compass and clipboards may also be required and good torches for all members of the crew. You should be familiar with the OS map conventions and how to read grid references. The ability to walk at a measured pace will be useful and all should have stout footwear and waterproof clothing.

There will be 24 clue locations, Entrants will be expected to visit no more than 18 of these locations and find answers to simple questions. Some of these might involve a short orienteering type exercise on foot. Scoring for correct answers will be weighted according to their difficulty and distance from the start/finish. To complete the event you will need to drive 40 to 50 miles. Competitors with a 3rd or 4th (or 5th!) crew member over 16 will receive a 10 point penalty per person.

Classes

Class 1. For Pre-War cars and Inter Register members;

There will be three ability classes; Beginners, Novices and Experts. Any crew member who has won a class award or better, in an IRC or VSCC rally in the last 5 years, is defined as an Expert. Beginners are those on their first Navigational Rally and will receive additional assistance if required. Novices are everyone else.

Class 2. Modern Cars, will be subdivided into Experts and Beginners if sufficient entries.

Inter Register Awards/Prizes to the best 3 car team and to the overall winner of each class.
