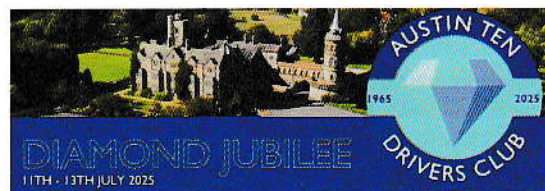

Class 1	10 hp <i>Chrome Rad</i> - Austin 10/4 models with flat exposed radiator cores. 1932-34, vans to 1936
Class 2	10 hp <i>Cowled Rad</i> - Austin 10/4 models, with cowled radiators 1934-36 - Lichfield, Sherborne, Ripley, Gordon Pixie 10hp Sports models from 1933 Colwyn, Open Road, and Clifton models up to 1937
Class 3	10hp Cambridge - Austin 10hp 1936-39 Cambridge, Conway, Cambridge van
Class 4	12-20hp <i>Chrome Rad</i> - All larger models with flat exposed radiator cores Saloons 1931-1934 Open cars up to 1935 and vans
Class 5	12-28hp <i>Cowled Rad</i> - All larger models, with cowled radiators 1934-39 includes Lt 12/6 Sports models from 1933 New Ascot / Goodwood style cars & vans from 1936
Class 6	Previous Winners - All class winners from Classes 1-6 from the last 5 years
<i>Awards for non-ATDC eligible cars. Judged independently, not under Pride of Ownership rules</i>	
Class 7	The Jim Richardson Award : For other Austins and cars of interest Any ATDC Member entered in the Rally, in any make of car or light commercial not covered by the classes 1-6 and that is regarded as a 'Historic Vehicle'
Class 8	As in Class 7 above, but for non-Austin Ten Drivers Club members First Prize and position rosettes will be awarded to Guest Rally entrants

Regional Shield	Awarded to the most popular car by public ballot
Fred Pace Memorial Trophy	Best 10/4 Two Seat & Dickey / Clifton in Classes 1 or 2 <i>Cars transported to the event on trailers are not eligible for this Trophy</i>
Kit Le Marquand Trophy	Best Club Eligible 6-cylinder car, 16hp and above in Class 5
Gary Ward Memorial Trophy	Awarded to the winning driver & navigator in the Scatter Run treasure hunt in a Club-eligible Austin (10-28hp 1931-39)
Long Distance Awards <i>GB & Overseas</i>	Farthest distance driven in a Club-eligible Austin to reach the event. <i>Cars transported on trailers not eligible for these awards</i>
Worst Breakdown Award	Most catastrophic breakdown sustained by a Club-eligible Austin on the way to or during the event. Cars recovered on a trailer are eligible!
Everyday Shield	Car in regular use throughout the year <i>Cars transported to this event on trailers are not eligible</i>
Light Twelve Shield	Best Light 12/4 or 12/6 in classes 4 or 5
The Longbridge Shield	Awarded to club-eligible cars for a specified area of the car, "As it left Longbridge" - Members will be advised via the magazine which area will be inspected
Driving Test	Best gentleman's score in driving tests in a Club-eligible car Best lady's score in driving tests in a Club-eligible car
Best Dressed Trophies	Best dressed lady and gentleman in 1930/1940s period costume
The 10/4 Challenge Cup	Best combined Pride of Ownership and Driving Test scores, 10hp
The 12-28 Challenge Cup	Best combined Pride of Ownership and Driving Test scores, 12-28hp

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMATION	
Vehicle Condition	All vehicles entered for the National Rally must be in a roadworthy condition and registered with the tax office (not SORN). All vehicles must be insured. Drivers must also be covered by insurance to drive the vehicle
Safety Instructions	The ATDC is a drivers' club and we rely on the knowledge and experience of members to ensure safe and enjoyable events. However, familiarity can lead to momentary lapses of concentration or departures from good practice and as organisers of a motoring event we are not allowed to assume common sense will always prevail
Driving and Vehicle Safety	To ensure the safe enjoyment of your event please follow these guidelines : YOU MUST ▪ Obey the instructions of the rally marshals including during the Driving Tests ▪ Check that your vehicle has no fuel leaks ▪ Always obey the 5mph speed limit on site ▪ If moving your vehicle after dark, do so with extreme caution YOU MUST NOT ▪ Refuel your vehicle within the rally venue grounds ▪ Drink and drive above the legal limit for alcohol ▪ Allow anyone without a license or insurance to drive your vehicle YOU SHOULD ▪ Make use of any designated vehicle movement routes ▪ Minimize car movements on the rally field ▪ Avoid reversing on the rally field where possible ▪ Keep your car speed down to a walking pace (5mph) on the rally field ▪ Pedestrians - please keep clear of moving cars and allow space for drivers to manoeuvre their vehicles
Pets	Pets are allowed in the grounds of the event. Please note that all dog waste must be cleared up. There is zero tolerance for dogs being kept in cars at any time of year, regardless of windows being left open or regular checks
Food and Drink	Tea and coffee will be available in the Horsley suite building throughout the weekend. This is included in your room rate. During the evening meals, the Hotel will provide bar staff to serve ale, wine, and soft drinks to be paid for separately on the night. Lunchtime meals can be ordered from the restaurant.
Bring & Buy Stall	Members can sell parts via their Stall. You must pay a booking fee of £5 in advance (£10 on the day) plus 10% of any receipts of the sale. The part must carry a label showing your name, contact No and Membership Number plus a Description of the part, price required (or acceptable offer). Any parts unsold and uncollected will be donated to the ATDC Spares Unit
Smoking	No smoking or e-cigarettes in buildings, marquees or other confined spaces
Drones	Flying of drones is not permitted on the rally site
