Virtual Navigational Rally Sunday 7th February 2021 REGULATIONS AND ENTRY FORM

The NHAEG, on behalf of the Austin Ten Drivers Club, hosted by Richard Long & Peter Christie, will stage a Virtual Table Top Navigational Rally on the 7th February 2021. This will form part of the Inter Register Club Championship series 2021 and will be held under *these* regulations and such others as may subsequently be issued prior to the event. The map will be OS Landranger series No. 149 (Hereford & Leominster) edition revised 2011 , re-printed 2016. (If you need a map you can get them at attractive prices from dash4it.co.uk)

A maximum of 40 entries will be accepted from members of all affiliated IRC member clubs, plus the VSCC and other invited clubs and individuals.

Navigation techniques will be used such as grid references, spot heights, herringbones, tulips and grid square directions. Not all routes will be on public roads. There will be eight sections and once you have arrived at the correct location you will then use Google Earth Streetview to look for answers to clues.

There will be two classes – Experts and Novices, defined as follows: **Expert** - An Expert is one who has been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in class on an IRC or VSCC rally within the past three years. (Actual or Virtual). **Novice** - A Novice is one who has entered an IRC or VSCC rally within the past three years but who has **NOT** been placed First, Second or Third in class (Actual or Virtual).
